

MSRTC starts Pune-Bangalore A/C Volvo Service

Maharashtra State Road Transport Corporation (MSRTC)'s new Air-Conditioned Volvo –Shivneri service on Pune-Bangalore route was recently flagged off by Hon'ble Shri Gulabrao Deokar, Minister of State for Transport & MSRTC's Chairman Mr Sudhakar Paricharak. Mr Deepak Kapoor, VC & MD of MSRTC graced the occasion. The bus leaves from Pune (Swargate) at 17.30 hrs and cover the distance of 850 kms via Kolhapur-Kagal-Belgaum-Dharwad-Hubli-Haveri-Harihar-Davangiri-Chitradurg-Tumkur to reach Bangalore on the next day at 8.45hrs. Similarly, the bus leaving from Bangalore at 18.15 hrs reaches Pune(Swargate) at 9.30 hrs on the next day. The fare is Rs 900/- for an adult.

MSRTC is providing blankets, mineral water & newspaper **free of cost** to the passengers to make their journey more comfortable.

With this air-conditioned service, the long standing demand of the passengers of Pune & Bangalore has been fulfilled. MSRTC Vice Chairman & Managing Director Mr Deepak Kapoor has urged citizens of both cities to utilize and take benefit of this service.
